



## Training Session for NY SHPO's Cultural Resource Information System

CRIS has been up for about three years now. The system continues to grow and evolve, and the SHPO reviewers have noticed some common issues. Archaeology Unit staff member Tim Lloyd will be hosting a training session to review the information available in CRIS; to discuss best practices for project submission, survey submission, and resource submission; and to answer questions.

### When and Where

The training session will immediately follow the Fall New York Archaeological Council Meeting on Saturday September 30<sup>th</sup> at the Peebles Island State Park Visitor Center in Waterford, NY. The CRIS session will be from 2:30 to 4:00 pm. The Visitor Center has a maximum capacity of 100 people and you don't have to be a NYAC member to attend the CRIS session. Put "Peebles Island State Park" into the GPS. As you enter the traffic circle on the Island, look for the sign pointing to the Visitor Center, where you'll see a cannon in front of the door, and then park in the main lot.
