

NYAC Awards Committee – Call for Nominations

The NYAC Awards Committee is soliciting nominations for three award categories: Founders, Lifetime Achievement, and Student Research.

Founders: honors individuals (professional archaeologists, avocational archaeologists, and non-archaeologists) who have assisted in the preservation of sites, and/or who have contributed substantially to our knowledge of the past.

Student Research: open to any undergraduate or graduate student conducting research in, or related to, New York State archaeology. Manuscripts may include analysis and interpretation of data collected during recent field research or research on extant collections.

Lifetime Achievement: recognizes individuals who have made a significant contribution to the field of archaeology, cultural resource management, or community outreach through instruction, research & scholarship, and/or leadership & service, over a minimum of 25 years. **This is not an annual award**, but instead intends to honor individuals who have achieved outstanding levels of contributions to archaeology.
