

## SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

*The Bulletin*, Journal of the New York State Archaeological Association is a journal devoted to the dissemination of scholarly articles relating to the archaeology of New York State and its environs and is published annually by the New York State Archaeological Association. Topics may include site reports, regional studies, artifact studies, artifact descriptions/ photos, etc. Position papers, rebuttals, or editorials will not be accepted for publication without prior permission from the Editor. News items and announcements should not be submitted to the journal, but are appropriate for the Newsletter. All submissions should be sent to the Editor and submitted in accordance with the following guidelines:

1. Please submit the manuscript as email attachments to the Editor. The manuscript should be in Microsoft Word, single-spaced with black type in 11 point Times New Roman font. Do not embed graphics or tables into this document. These are to be submitted separately. Send to Roger.Quad50@gmail.com.
2. Tables used in the manuscript should be submitted in a separate Microsoft Excel file.
3. Manuscripts should not exceed 25 pages in length (single-spaced), including illustrations, tables, photographs, and references, unless special permission is granted in advance by the Editor.  
Manuscripts must include:  
Title, author(s), institutional or chapter affiliation  
Abstract of 150 words or fewer  
Acknowledgements  
References cited  
Tables (with captions)  
Figures (with captions listed on a separate page)
4. Electronic images for photographs and illustrations should be submitted at 300 dpi resolution or higher as either jpeg or tiff files. Color photographs or images can be submitted, but may be published in black and white. Do not copy or embed into documents. This lowers the resolution. Captions for photos and illustrations should be included in the text file and not appear in the graphic itself. Send as attachments to Roger.Quad50@gmail.com. For extremely large files Dropbox or WeTransfer are recommended.
5. Reference citation format follows *American Antiquity* style ([www.saa.org](http://www.saa.org) or any issue of *The Bulletin* Number 118 or beyond). Please follow this format. These may be edited for consistency.
6. Peer review is optional at the author's discretion.
7. Submitted manuscripts must be exclusive to *The Bulletin* (i.e., not submitted to other journals for publication).
8. Approval of submissions for publication is at the sole discretion of the Editor.
9. If the submission is approved for publication, the author will be required to assign all copyrights related to the submission to The New York State Archaeological Association prior to publication. 10. Submitted materials will not be returned to the author, regardless of whether or not the submission is approved for publication. Consequently, the author should retain a copy of all submitted materials.
